Born in 1876 Honolulu, James Judd, the grandson of missionaries, was a private practice physician and graduate of Oahu College, Yale and Columbia Universities; he gave distinguished professional service in three wars, the Spanish-American and World Wars I and II and helped found the Kauaikeolani Childrens Hospital. In World War I both he and Mrs. Judd (ne Louise Marshall of Chicago), who served as nurses assistant, went to France and served in the battle areas. they volunteered with the American Ambulance Service long before the U. S. entered the conflict, and went to France together in 1915. Dr. Judd served first in Neuilly Hospital Seine, and was later made chief surgeon of the Juilly Hospital, Seine et Marne, from 1915-17. Mrs. Judd also served, nursing at the hospitals to which her husband was assigned. Dr. Judd was awarded the Legion on Honor decoration on July 14, 1921, in recognition of his conspicuous services to the French government during the war. In 1917 Dr. Judd wrote and published With the American Ambulance in France. All profits from its sale were sent to aid the fatherless children of France....
